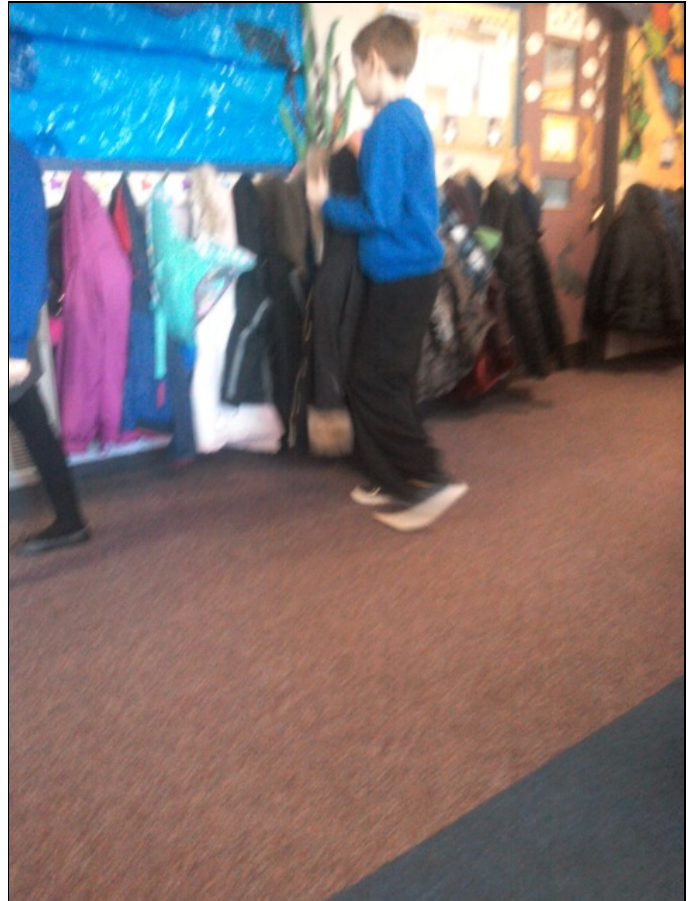
Respect
