Dear Parents / Carers,

Following the Government's announcement on Monday evening, we have worked tirelessly to make arrangements to educate our children of key workers and our vulnerable children at school. We know this has taken a day or two and we apologise for the slight delay in getting this information to you.

You will have received an email from us informing you that your child has been allocated a place. From next week and every week moving forwards until the end of lockdown, you will need to book your child's place on WisePay each week. Whilst there will always be a place for your child, if there is ever an opportunity for you to keep your child/ren at home then they should be kept home. School should be seen as a last resort and wherever possible we should all be following the government's stay at home order.

From Friday 8th January 2021, the following arrangements will be in place.

Dropping off

Gates will open at 8:30am for all children who have been allocated a place at school ready for an 8:45am start. Parents should walk children onto the school site with Nursery and Reception going in via the gate to the EYFS outside area and Year 1 and 2 children going straight into their classrooms. Key Stage 2 children should walk themselves in via the pedestrian gate, head straight around to the Key Stage 2 playground and then straight into class.

Collection

Gates will open at 3:00pm and all children will finish at 3:15pm. Children in Nursery and Reception will be collected from the EYFS outside area therefore, parents need to queue on the left-hand side. Children in Years 1-6 will be collected from the Key Stage 1 playground, so parents need to queue on the right hand. At 3:15pm, you will be able to pick your child up from the playground or email us at <u>beanfield.admin@beanfieldprimary.org</u> to let us know that you are happy for your child to walk home. **Even if you have emailed us this information before, please let us know again if you would like your child to walk home alone.**

<u>Uniform</u>

All children from Reception to Year 6 are expected to attend school in full school uniform except on their PE days where children should attend school in their PE kit. PE days are as follows:

Reception – Friday Year 1 – Wednesday Year 2 – Tuesday Year 3- Tuesday

If you would like your child to have a school lunch then please book this on WisePay in the usual way. We will still be providing hot meals following our published menus.

Children can bring in a bag/rucksack as usual in which they should put their water bottle and a snack. Please note, we will not be providing snacks in school for Early Years or Key Stage 1 children. Those children having a packed lunch from home should bring this in.
