Year 3 Beaumanor Residential trip - April 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the interest towards the Year 3–residential, we are pleased to announce that we will be booking the trip and are able to share the key details of the visit to Beaumanor Outdoor Learning Centre which will take place from 19th- 21st April 2021.

The children will spend their time at Beaumanor taking part in the following daytime and evening activities aimed at building both their teamwork skills and confidence; Orienteering, Archery, Bridge building, Indoor wall climbing, Survival, Nightline and Cellars.

We have 32 places available on the trip with 16 places for girls and 16 places for boys. These places will be allocated on a first come first served basis where a signed permission slip has been received and a non-refundable deposit of £50 has been paid on Wisepay by 7th June 2019. At this time it is unknown if the government will allow schools to resume residential trips in the Spring term. If updated guidance advises against this then the trip will unfortunately be cancelled. In this situation all deposits will be refunded. Once we receive updated guidance regarding residential trips for the Spring term we will be in contact with you again with further updates.

The overall cost of the trip will depend on the number of children going. We will require a minimum of 12 children for the trip to be able to go ahead and have calculated that taking into account a slight increase from last year the maximum cost will be no more than £280. If we are able to fill all 32 places however we will be able to reduce the cost.

To secure your child's place on the trip, please read the attached terms and conditions then complete and return the permission slip as soon as possible. Once this has been received, the trip will be made available for you on Wisepay. You will then need to follow the checkout instructions to pay the initial instalment by 31st October 2020. If you need assistance in using Wisepay, please email <u>Beanfield.admin@beanfieldprimary.org</u> for support.

After the deadline, the exact cost and payment plan will be calculated and shared. Failure to make payments on time or complete the full payment will result in your child losing their place on the trip. If you have any further questions regarding this trip, please do not hesitate to call the school office or email <u>Beanfield.admin@beanfieldprimary.org</u> and a member of staff from the trip will make contact with you.

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Terms and Conditions - Year 3 Beaumanor Residential trip – April 2021

General

Any student leaving Beanfield Primary prior to the trip will not be permitted to travel and will forfeit all monies paid.

Non-refundable deposits

All deposits are non-refundable.

Non-refundable payments

Should a student withdraw from the trip or be unable to travel, you will be liable for monies paid to the Travel Company by Beanfield Primary in accordance with the detailed payment schedule, unless covered by the insurance or there are students on the waiting list for the trip who are able to take the place. Deposits, in this case, are still non-refundable as Beanfield Primary may incur administration charges imposed by the Travel Company.

Health form and emergency contact details

It is a pre-requisite for every trip that students provide a completed and signed form containing details of any existing medical conditions plus details of any medication they are currently taking. Twenty-four hour emergency contact details for students must be provided to us prior to the trip.

Conduct

The Principal reserves the right to remove any student from any trip in the event of a serious behavioural incident occurring prior to the date of travel. Any refund will be at the discretion of the Principal.

Insurance

Health and travel insurance is included in the price of the trip. Full details can be made available on request.

Force Majeure

Beanfield Primary cannot accept liability, make any refunds or pay any compensation where circumstances amounting to 'force majeure' prevent travel. Circumstances mounting to 'force majeure' include any event which the tour company or Beanfield Primary could not, even with all due care, foresee or forestall such as (by way of example not by way of limitation) war, threat of war, riot, civil unrest, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, acts of God, adverse weather conditions, and all similar events. The final decision concerning the safety and viability of any trip rests with the Principal, who will, where possible consult with parents beforehand.

Payment schedule

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No outstanding balance on student account

The Principal reserves the right to refuse a place to any student who has a substantial outstanding balance on their account, either on payment of the deposit or at any time thereafter. In addition, it is expected that all accounts will be settled in full no later than one month prior to departure or by the final date of the payment schedule (whichever is sooner)
