Google Assembly for Parents on Internet Safety



On Tuesday 3rd March Parentzone, an organisation providing support for children, families and schools on navigating the internet safely and confidently, are coming into school to deliver an assembly to Key Stage 2 children to raise awareness of the importance of staying safe online. The "Be Internet Legends" assemblies have been developed alongside Google to support children with staying smart online.

We are lucky that Parentzone have also offered to run a follow-up session for parents, carers and children straight after school on this day. The interactive session will take place at 3.20pm for about 20 to 30 minutes and will focus on:

- Raising awareness among parents about 'Be Internet Legends'
- Sharing what children are learning
- Encouraging families to continue the conversation and get involved at home

There will be an opportunity for children who have stayed behind after the assembly to 'challenge' parents with a series of true or false questions about tech use - but the emphasis will be on engaging and enthusing families on positive use of technology.
