**School Uniform**

As winter is approaching and the weather conditions outside are changing, we thought now would be a good time to send out a reminder about our expectations for children's school uniform. We are very proud of our uniform and coming to school in correct uniform is an important part of belonging to our school community.

Below are our expectations for uniform for girls and boys:

<p>Practical, sensible black/dark shoes – coloured trainers or trainers with stripes/logos are not acceptable.</p>	

As well as their indoor uniform may we also please remind you to send your child in with a coat suitable for wearing outside in the cold weather and in light rain as we try to ensure children get their outdoor break and lunchtime as much as possible.

The official, logoed uniform can be purchased from Karlsports, however a range of alternatives are available at local supermarkets. We do understand that purchasing uniform can sometimes be difficult and to support parents with obtaining all the correct items at a cost effective price we will be selling second hand uniform during both parents evening sessions on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> November, in the Key Stage 1 hall. A range of jumpers, t-shirts, fleeces and other items will be available in all sizes. As ever, if you require any additional support please contact the Wellbeing Team who may be able to help.

Please make sure that **all** your child's uniform is clearly labelled with their name. When uniform is correctly labelled we are able to return any misplaced items usually within the same day however if uniform is not labelled it is very difficult to return it to the children.

Many thanks for your continued support in ensuring your children look smart and are representing Beanfield well in every aspect of school life.
