Steffi Graf

Steffi Graf was a tennis sensation in the late 80's and early 90's. She is the only player ever to win each of the grand slams four times, and has the second most grand slam wins of any tennis player ever, behind Margaret Court. She has two Olympic gold medals under her belt, along with one silver and bronze. She was ranked number one for a record 377 weeks.
