


Today, we are learning to: plan a narrative

What should we include in a narrative?

- Fronted adverbials
- Speech
- A variety of sentence types
- Paragraphs

When we plan, we need to think about whether what we are going to describe is positive or negative.

Think about:

Is the setting beautiful or ugly looking?

Would the smells be good or bad?

Are the sounds pleasant or unpleasant?

Are the characters nice or nasty?

When we know if a sentence has a positive or negative focus, we can look at what specific vocabulary we can use to describe this. Draw this planning grid into your books.
