



This whole project has been designed as 4 tasks to be completed over a couple of days.


Task 3

To complete your landscape picture, you can use any media available to you at home, coloured pencils, felt tips, paint, collage from cutting colours from magazines or fabric or a mixture of media.

If using pencils or pens, think about how you can add texture and detail into your landscape - for example using felt tip pen on top of paint or pencil to show flowers in the foreground, shading individual fields or adding crops. Remember the sky isn't all one shade of blue.
